The Expo has been developed as a platform for the Bathurst arts community to showcase and promote their work to the community and visitors alike. Presented by the Bathurst Arts Council, the inaugural Expo will run from 20 to 21 November 2010 at the Bathurst Showground.

Exhibitors will be housed in the historical Beau Brown Pavilion with the Arts Alive 2795 Art Park presenting performances from local artists on the Performance Stage alongside the Children's Corner Reading Room and Craft Room, The 2795 Primary School art and writing competition, talent quest and a French Cafe and wine tastings.

Held in conjunction with the well known Bathurst's Biggest Expo, attendance figures are estimated at 4,000 plus - so the Arts Alive 2795 Expo presents a rare opportunity of en masse exposure of artists work, promotion of organisations and associations or circulation of training and teaching information. Visitors will discover or acquire that unique something-special art piece, catch an engaging performance or meet and talk with local artists.
